FOR BC COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY TRANSFER STUDENTS

EXCELLENCE

OUR ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS RECOGNIZE THE EXCEPTIONAL ACADEMIC, COMMUNITY, ARTISTIC AND ATHLETIC ACHIEVEMENTS OF BC COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY TRANSFER STUDENTS.

APPLY FOR THESE SCHOLARSHIPS

Application required: for details consult students.sfu.ca/entrancescholarships.html.

\$10,000 Honourable William M. Hamilton Scholarships

Recognize high academic achievement and leadership potential for students transferring from a BC college with a minimum transfer average of 3.50. Must be a Canadian citizen or Permanent Resident.

\$3,500 Canadian University Transfer Scholarships

Recognize high academic achievement for students transferring from a Canadian university with a minimum transfer average of 3.70. May be Canadian citizen, Permanent Resident or international student.

BE CONSIDERED AUTOMATICALLY FOR THESE SCHOLARSHIPS

\$3,500 Ken Caple Scholarships

Recognize outstanding academic performance for students transferring from a BC college with a minimum transfer average of 3.70. No application required. Must be a Canadian citizen or Permanent Resident.

\$3,500 International Summit Scholarships

Recognize outstanding academic performance for international students transferring from a BC college with a minimum transfer average of 3.70. No application required.

GENERAL CRITERIA

Only students who are transferring their BC college or Canadian university credits directly to Simon Fraser University, are eligible for these entrance scholarships. Check students.sfu.ca/entrancescholarships.html for details.

TRAVEL ALLOWANCE

Winners who live outside school districts 34 Abbotsford, 35 Langley, 36 Surrey, 37 Delta, 38 Richmond, 39 Vancouver, 40 New Westminster, 41 Burnaby, 42 Maple Ridge-Pitt Meadows, 43 Coquitlam, 44 North Vancouver and 45 West Vancouver, may receive a one-time travel allowance of \$500.

OTHER FINANCIAL AID AND AWARDS OPPORTUNITIES

PROCESS FOR BC COLLEGE TRANSFERS

STUDENTS TRANSFERRING FROM A BC COLLEGE MAY APPLY FOR THE \$10,000 HONOURABLE WILLIAM M. HAMILTON ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP.

STEP 1

- apply for admission to SFU at: www.sfu.ca/futurestudents.html by the following deadlines:
April 30 for Fall term (September-December)
September 30 for Spring term (January-April)
January 31 for Summer term (May-August)

STEP 2

- pay the admission application fee and send in all required documents for your admission. For a list of required documents, check your “to do” list at: sis.sfu.ca. You can access your SFU student account with the user ID and password that is emailed to you after you have applied for admission.

STEP 3: APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP

- mail the completed application, with supporting documents, so that we receive your package by the same admission deadline for the term to which you applied.

DEADLINE AND MAILING ADDRESS

Submit your complete application package by the appropriate deadline to: Entrance Scholarships, Student Services, MBC 3200, Simon Fraser University, 8888 University Drive, Burnaby, BC V5A 1S6.

WHAT'S NEXT

Once we receive your scholarship application package and have determined that you are eligible, you will be considered for the appropriate scholarship. You may receive only one SFU entrance scholarship.

Scholarship winners will be notified in writing. Only successful candidates will be contacted.

SEND US THESE DOCUMENTS

- a completed, signed application form, available as a fillable pdf at students.sfu.ca/entrancescholarships.html.
- two letters of reference from your College faculty members. Both referees should be able to base their letters on direct knowledge about you and should know you well enough to comment on your abilities, especially in relation to your ranking and academic performance among other students in your college.
- a one page summary of your achievements and activities.
- a 900 word essay on one of the following quotes from some of SFU's honorary degree recipients:
 1. “Who is your Spark?”—Wendy Grant John, First Nations Chief
 2. “Resilience was the first concept that shaped my growing understanding of change.”—C.S. (Buzz) Holling, one of the conceptual founders of ecological economics
 3. “We’re constantly being told what other people think we are, and that’s why it is so important to know yourself.”—Sarah McLachlan, musician and singer
- a transcript of your grades.

All of these documents must be fastened together and submitted in a single envelope. Documents **MUST NOT** arrive separately. Packages with extra materials or late documents will not be accepted.

PROCESS FOR CANADIAN UNIVERSITY TRANSFERS

STUDENTS TRANSFERRING FROM A CANADIAN UNIVERSITY MAY APPLY FOR THE \$3,500 CANADIAN UNIVERSITY TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP.

STEP 1

- apply for admission to SFU at:
www.sfu.ca/futurestudents.html
by the following deadlines:
April 30 for Fall term (September-December)
September 30 for Spring term (January-April)
January 31 for Summer term (May-August)

STEP 2

- pay the admission application fee and send in all required documents for your admission. For a list of required documents, check your “to do” list at: sis.sfu.ca. You can access your SFU student account with the user ID and password that is emailed to you after you have applied for admission.

STEP 3: APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP

- mail the completed application, with supporting documents, so that we receive your package by the same admission deadline for the term to which you applied.

SEND US THESE DOCUMENTS

- one letter of reference from your University faculty members Your referee should be able to base their letters on direct knowledge about you and should know you well enough to comment on your abilities, especially in relation to your ranking and academic performance among other students in your university.
- a transcript of your grades, transferring 24 to 60 credits only.

All of these documents must be fastened together and submitted in a single envelope. Documents **MUST NOT** arrive separately. Packages with extra materials or late documents will not be accepted.
