



Simon Fraser University's India Entrance Scholarship is targeted to high school students graduating from a secondary educational institution in India with the highest academic performance. Canadian citizens, permanent residents or international students can be eligible for this award. Up to a maximum of three scholarships are awarded annually every Fall term. The total value of each scholarship is \$10,000 divided into two equal installments of \$5,000 each.

CRITERIA

Awards will be granted on the basis of demonstrated excellence in one or more of the following:

- academic achievement
- community service
- cultural contribution

STEP 1

All applicants must apply for admission to SFU and pay the admission application fee in order to be considered.

STEP 2

Mail this application and supporting documents to SFU at the address below. We must receive your package by May 31 in order for you to be considered for entry to the Fall term.

Send us these documents:

- this paper application form, original or photocopied, completed and signed.
- one reference letter. The referee should be able to base his or her reference on direct knowledge about you.
- a one page essay that outlines your interest in one or more of the programs at SFU, and why you would be a worthy recipient of this entrance scholarship.
- one copy of your most recent high school transcript showing your Grade 11 and 12 grades. We will accept midterm marks for courses in progress.

All of the above documents must be fastened together and submitted in a single large envelope. Documents must not arrive separately. Mail your package to the address at the bottom of this form to reach SFU by May 31.
